MASTER BEDROOM

- Overhead ceiling fixture for general lighting
- Bedside lamps or reading lights
- Wardrobe / closet lighting
- Dimmable, sconce or under-bed mood lighting

MASTER BATHROOM

- Vanity lighting at mirror
- Shower / tub lighting
- Task lighting at vanity or makeup area
- Dimmable, accent or indirect lighting

CHILDREN'S BEDROOMS

- Overhead ceiling fixture
- Desk lamp for homework or reading
- Closet / cabinet lighting
- Colour-changing, nightlight or feature lighting

FAMILY / ENTERTAINMENT ROOM

- Ceiling light or fan with lights
- Floor or table lamps in seating areas
- Task lighting near games or media zones
- Dimmable, accent or wall-washer lighting

KITCHEN / DINING

- Recessed ceiling lights
- Under-cabinet lighting
- Pendant lights above island or table
- Dimmable, toe-kick or decorative feature lighting

HOME OFFICE / LIBRARY

- Desk lamp
- Overhead ceiling fixture
- Bookcase lighting
- Dimmable, wall sconce or picture lighting

LIGHTING CHECKLIST

Additional spaces checklist

Review the lighting layers needed for specialist and secondary spaces. Final lighting layouts should always be coordinated with joinery, furniture, equipment and outdoor features.

1. OUTDOOR LIVING SPACES

- Ceiling fans with lights
- Pathway lighting
- Security lighting
- String, landscape or fire feature lighting



2. GAMES ROOM

- Overhead ceiling fixture
- Table or floor lamps
- Pendant lights above game tables
- Dimmable, LED strip or neon feature lighting



3. HOME CINEMA

- Recessed ceiling lights
- Dimmable sconces or cove lighting
- LED step lights
- Rope lighting or starlight ceiling



4. HOME POOL

- Underwater pool lights
- Pool deck lighting
- Landscape lighting
- Colour-changing or water feature lighting



5. WINE / WHISKEY ROOM

- Ceiling lights for label reading
- Wall sconces or picture lights
- Task lighting at tasting area
- Dimmable, LED strip or display case lighting



6. UPSTAIRS LAUNDRY

- Overhead ceiling fixture
- Task lighting at counters
- Under-cabinet lighting
- Dimmable, sconce or decorative lighting
