**MASTER BEDROOM**

- Bedside: 2 double sockets per side of bed
- Dressing area: 2 double sockets
- Entertainment area: 1 double socket
- General use: 2 double sockets

**MASTER BATHROOM**

- Vanity: 2 double sockets
- Bath / spa zone: 1 double socket
- Heated towel rail: 1 single socket or spur
- General use: 1 double socket

**CHILDREN'S BEDROOMS**

- Bedside: 2 double sockets per side of bed
- Study area: 2 double sockets
- Entertainment area: 1 double socket
- General use: 2 double sockets



04

**FAMILY / ENTERTAINMENT ROOM**

- Entertainment centre: 2 double sockets
- Seating areas: 1 double socket per seating arrangement
- Bar area: 2 double sockets
- General use: 2 double sockets



05

**KITCHEN / DINING**

- Worktop appliances: 4 double sockets above counter
- Cooking area: 2 double sockets
- Island: 2 double sockets
- Dining / general: 1 double socket plus 2 additional doubles

**HOME OFFICE / LIBRARY**

- Desk area: 4 double sockets
- Reading area: 1 double socket
- Entertainment area: 1 double socket
- General use: 2 double sockets

# Additional spaces checklist

Review these allowances for specialist and secondary spaces. Final locations should always be coordinated with furniture layouts, equipment and outdoor design.

## 1. OUTDOOR LIVING SPACES

- Seating area: 2 double sockets
- Outdoor cooking area: 2 double sockets
- Entertainment area: 1 double socket
- Pool equipment / general: 1 single plus 2 double sockets



## 2. GAMES ROOM

- Gaming area: 2 double sockets
- Bar area: 2 double sockets
- Seating areas: 1 double socket per seating arrangement
- General use: 2 double sockets



## 3. HOME CINEMA

- Projector / screen area: 2 double sockets
- Seating areas: 1 double socket per seating arrangement
- Snack area: 2 double sockets
- General use: 2 double sockets



## 4. HOME POOL

- Pool equipment: 1 single socket
- Entertainment area: 2 double sockets
- Landscape lighting / ambience: 2 double sockets
- General use: 2 double sockets



## 5. WINE / WHISKEY ROOM

- Wine fridge: 1 double socket
- Tasting area: 1 double socket
- Display lighting: 1 double socket
- General use: 2 double sockets



## 6. UPSTAIRS LAUNDRY

- Washing machine: 1 double socket
- Dryer: 1 double socket
- Ironing area: 1 double socket
- General use: 1 double socket
